

### SET Stepping up marketer's training

The Stock Exchange of Thailand expects to train more than 5,000 marketing representatives this year, part of a broader programme to help expand the local investor base.

Punsak Vejanurak, SET executive vice-president, said 2,799 people had been trained to date under courses offered by the Thailand Securities Institute. The total included 2,150 people trained as certified marketing representatives for debt instruments and 275 under equity courses.

Naowarat Bumrungchit, the TSI director, said that the institute, in collaboration with Progress Information Co, Programme by 60% to 800 baht for 25 hours for applicants registering before sept 30.
